Flushing anything but human waste and toilet paper can clog pipes, damage sewer lift stations and contaminate our water, including:

WIPES & NAPKINS

Sanitary wipes, baby wipes, napkins, paper towels ... even so-called "flushable" wipes aren't really sewer safe.





PRESCRIPTION MEDS

Unused medications should not be flushed or thrown in the trash, but disposed of in a secure county drop-box.

DIAPERS & FEMININE HYGIENE PRODUCTS

Flushing diapers and feminine hygiene products can also clog your pipes.
