It's a great way to see if your family is staying on track of your water saving goals even during the holiday chaos.

Plus, our portal can flag excessive water use and alert you to potential leaks.

If you find a leak, you might qualify for a leak adjustment to your bill if you get a repair promptly.

To be eligible for a water leak adjustment, customers must report the leak within 60 days of the bill due date for the billing period when the leak occurred by completing a Water Leak Adjustment Form.

A leak adjustment may be granted when the District finds one is warranted.
