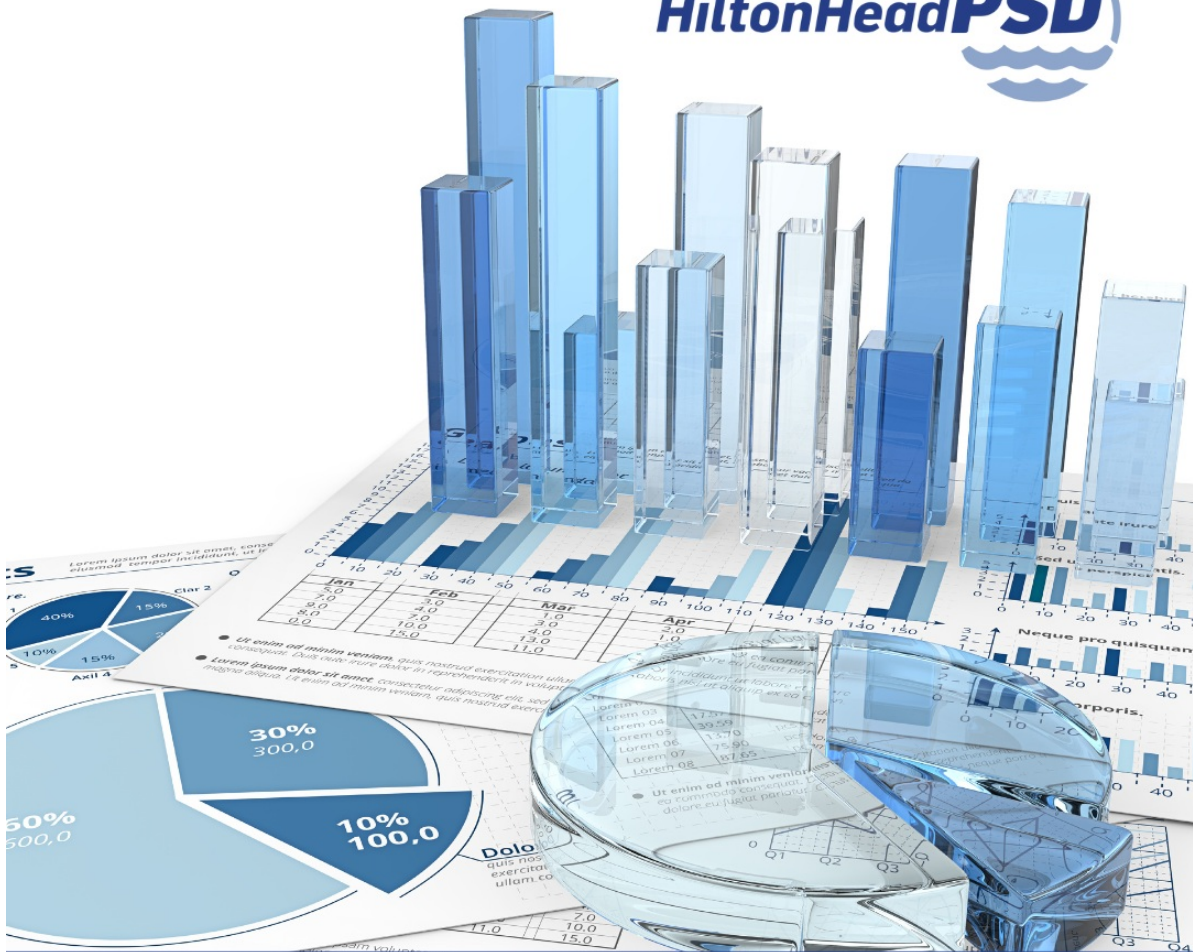

It's National Infrastructure Week!

This annual, nationwide event focuses on raising awareness about the importance of infrastructure and advocating for improvements that address some of our nation's toughest challenges in transit and transportation, water systems, energy, connectivity, and more.

It's a great time to learn about some of the PSD's current projects — including construction of our new well, which is underway near the Old Welcome Center.

New Drinking Water Well Under Construction

Construction is underway at the site of the Old Welcome Center on William Hilton Parkway and at the Ashmore Tract near the intersection of Union Cemetery Road and William Hilton Parkway. Crews will be installing water mains under William Hilton Parkway in both locations.

The projects include construction of a fourth well to provide water necessary to expand the capacity of our Reverse Osmosis Drinking Water Treatment Facility to 6 million gallons a day, as well as construction of a second Aquifer Storage & Recovery Well that will be capable of storing approximately 260 million gallons of treated drinking water – key infrastructure for meeting peak demands and providing resiliency for our water system.

As the weather heats up, make sure you're following Hilton Head's local ordinance for irrigation.

That means limiting your water use for irrigation to twice per week — and making sure your irrigation system has a working rain gauge.

You should also avoid watering during the heat of the day; stick to early mornings or evenings for watering.
